AMBIGUITY AROUND MASK REQUIREMENTS CAUSES CONFUSION IN BC STRATA CORPORATIONS

NEW WESTMINSTER – With the recent health order once again mandating the use of masks in many indoor spaces BC strata corporations are left wondering if masks are required on common property. This confusion stems from the fact that the Provincial Health Order does not apply to a strata corporation.
